

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Govt. S.T. School, Unit-VI, Bhubaneswar, Khurda (Orissa)** for **Teachers' Certificate (C.T.) course** of Two years duration from the academic session **2001-2002** with an annual intake of 50 students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. The institution shall function with Principal / Head, eight teaching staff excluding PET, Hindi/Classical and Art, Craft and Music teacher and other supporting staff possessing the qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms and in the salary structure prescribed by the Central Government/State Government as the case may be.
2. The institution shall ensure library with 1500 books, Journals, laboratories, Hostel and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms within six months.
3. The construction of the building should be completed within one year and the institution shall shift on to its own building and premises.
4. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating Board/ State Government.
5. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating university/State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
6. Curriculum transaction, including practical work/activities, should be organised as per the NCTE norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating body /examining body.
7. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
8. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The Performance Appraisal Report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 7 above.

If **Govt. S.T. School, Unit – VI, Bhubaneswar, Khurda (Orissa)** contravenes any of the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder, or fails to fulfil the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.


Reference letter No. 240/ D dated 23.4.2004 received from the Director, Teacher Education & SCERT, Orissa on the subject cited above.

2. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 44th meeting held on 30.4.2004 considered the report of Director, TE & SCERT, Orissa and as State Govt. representative of Orissa in connection with the present staff position in all the 50 Govt. Secondary Training Schools of Orissa, who has assured the Committee that Government is taking steps to appoint Headmasters and teachers wherever they are vacant. The DPC is being held shortly. The reply from the NCTE Headquarters regarding relaxation of NCTE norms in respect of teaching staff is also awaited.

3. In consideration of the above facts, the Committee decided that pending decision of the Council, permission is hereby granted for admission into CT course in 50 recognized Govt. Secondary Training Schools of Orissa (as per list at Appendix-A) for the session **2004-2005** with approved intake mentioned against each institution subject to condition that 01 Headmaster and the teaching staff in all vacant posts be appointed before commencement of the academic session and the teacher – pupil ratio is maintained as per NCTE norms (one Headmaster and five qualified teachers for an intake of 50).

4. State Govt. should take immediate steps to appoint the Headmasters and teachers as per NCTE norms and submit a report before the commencement of the academic session.

WHEREAS in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Govt. Secondary Training School (W), Bhubaneswar, Plot No.- 722, Street No. - Unit-6, Vill - Ganganagar, PO - Surya Nagar, Tehsil/Taluka - Bhubaneswar, Town/City - Bhubaneswar, Dist - Khordha, Odisha- 751001 has submitted an application (Code No. ERCAPP1892) to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for conducting D.El.Ed Course (Additional Intake) with an additional annual intake of 50 (fifty) by online on (mm/dd/yyyy) 7/19/2013 and hard copy of application submitted on (mm/dd/yyyy) 7/22/2013.

2. AND WHEREAS the NCTE Hqs. vide letter No.A78554, dated 3.12.2013 granted relaxation for increase of intake capacity in the existing teacher training institutions in the State of Odisha with following observation and direction.

... An assurance/undertaking has been given by the Government of Odisha, to the NCTE accordingly, that they will fulfill all the criteria, procedural as well as infrastructural, for the teacher education institutions in the State by December, 2014. The Commissioner-cum Secretary to the Government of Odisha vide her letter No.25410/SME dated 05.11.2013 has conveyed that to make good the deficiencies in the staff position, 65 teacher educators have been appointed in different teacher training institutions on a regular basis. Furthermore, 116 more teacher educators under in-service quota have been selected and in a very short time they will be posted. Besides this the process of filling up other vacant posts will be made within March, 2014.

In view of the above, it has been decided, as a one time measure to relax the procedural and infrastructural requirements for the Teacher Education Programmes, proposed to be set up/run by the Government of Odisha. During this period, the Regional Director, ERC would take a view of the shortcomings and convey the same to the State Government of Odisha, NCTE and the Govt. of India for necessary action at their end to fulfill the requirements under the NCTE Rules and Regulations. The procedural and the staff requirements will be complied with by the Government of Odisha in a period of 4-6 weeks of the communication by NCTE. The infrastructural requirements would be fulfilled by December, 2014; the State Government shall however, make adequate infrastructural arrangements on lease/rental basis as per the stipulations of NCTE, before approval.

Accordingly, the procedure for processing the request of the Government of Odisha would be initiated; the formal letter of approval would however, be issued subject to the following to conditions:

- (i) All staff as per the norms and standards of NCTE is in place by February 2014.
- (ii) There is an adequate budgetary allocation in the budget of the State Government for the year 2014-15, for provision of requisite infrastructure as per the norms and standards of NCTE.

NCTE Headquarters would keep a watch on the situation and keep Government of Odisha and MHRD apprised of the shortcomings so that the same can be fulfilled expeditiously, within the period of relaxation. In case, at the end of December, 2014 all the criteria, as per the rules and regulations of the NCTE are not fulfilled, NCTE would be at liberty to withdraw the recognition given to the respective teacher education institutions recommended by the Government of Odisha.

Keeping in the above in view the Eastern Regional Office shall process the applications of the 71 Teacher Education Institutions referred by the State Government and dispose the same expeditiously as per NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations.

3. AND WHEREAS the ERC, NCTE as per the decision of 166th meeting held on 19th - 20th December 2013 communicated to the Commissioner-Cum-Secretary, Department of School and Mass Education, Govt. of Odisha to comply the following requirement.

- (a) List of the faculty for each institution duly countersigned by the Director T.E. & SCERT.
- (b) Status of budgetary allocation of the State Govt. for the year 2014-2015 for provision of requisite infrastructure for all institutions as per the Norms and Standards of NCTE.

4. AND WHEREAS as the Commissioner-Cum-Secretary, School & Mass Education Department, Govt. of Odisha vide letter No.2476 dated 06.02.2014 as well as the Director T.E & SCERT, Odisha, Bhubaneswar vide letter No.809 dated 11.02.2014 intimated the initiative taken by the Govt. of Odisha as given under.

- (1) Against the vacant posts ninety five Teacher Educators have been appointed in different DIETs/DRCs and 116 Teacher Educators have been selected but due to court case, the process of appointment has been delayed, very soon they will be posted.
- (2) A budget provision of Rs.30 Crores have been made by the State Government to make good the deficiencies in infrastructure.
- (3) The Department has prepared road map to complete the work within the stipulated time by proposing the project to Expenditure Finance Committee (EFC).
- (4) Amount required for completion of the incomplete building works of DIETs and DRCs under CSP shall borne by the State Govt.
- (5) The Government is also taking responsibility to provide all other facilities whichever will be required as per Rules and Regulations of NCTE.

5. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to Govt. Secondary Training School (W), Bhubaneswar, Plot No.- 722, Street No. - Unit-6, Vill - Ganganagar, PO - Surya Nagar, Tehsil/Taluka - Bhubaneswar, Town/City - Bhubaneswar, Dist - Khordha, Odisha- 751001 for conducting D.El.Ed. Course of Elementary (level) of two year duration with an additional annual intake of 50 (fifty), thus making the total annual intake of 100 (one hundred) from the academic session 2014-2015 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.

6. The recognition/permission is subject to fulfilment of the following:

- (i) The deficiencies being communicated after the inspection of institution to be complied within the stipulated period stated in the relaxation order of NCTE Hqrs.
- (ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (iii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) All such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
- (vi) The institution shall submit the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (vii) The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
 - a. Copy of the Application Form
 - b. Land and Building Particulars
 - c. Staff Profile
 - d. Recognition/permission letter
 - e. Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition/permission as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, they may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in the "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days of the issue of the order.

Subject:- OPENING OF 50 NEW SECONDARY TRAINING SCHOOLS IN THE STATE DURING 1973-74.

In continuation of G.O.No.27329 dt.12.9.73 I am directed to convey the sanction of Governor to the creation of 50 posts of Headmasters in class III of gazetted rank in the scale of Rs.260-540/-p.m.for the 50 new Government Secondary Training Schools opened in the G.O. referred to above with effect from 25.7.73 during 1973-74.

The above posts carry usual D.A. as admissible under rules.

The charge is debitable to Demand No.11 39 Misc. Social and Developmental Organisation-Special Welfare scheme providing employment to the educated unemployed-D-spl-(a)-Govt. Special Schools-Training Schools-opening of new Secondary Trg. Schools-pay of officers allowances(voted)" in the Budget Estimate for 1973-74.

As no specific provision exist for the purpose advance has been sanctioned from O.C.F. in Finance Department order no. 34616 E dt. 21.7.72.

No expenditure shall be incurred exceeding the amount sanctioned in O.C.F. until funds for the purpose are appropriated by law.

Sub:- OPENING OF 50 NEW SECONDARY TRAINING SCHOOLS IN THE STATE DURING 1973-74.

I am directed to convey the sanction of Governor to the opening of 50 new Government Secondary Training Schools in the state as listed in Annexure I together with necessary staff and money grants as detailed in Annexure-II with effect from 25.7.73 to 28.2.74 during 1973-74.

The posts mentioned in annexure-II will carry usual D.A. as admissible under rules.
